## Personal Items for each Scout:

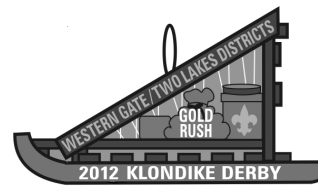
Tin Foil Dinner, Candy Bar or Trail Snacks, Hot cocoa Packages
